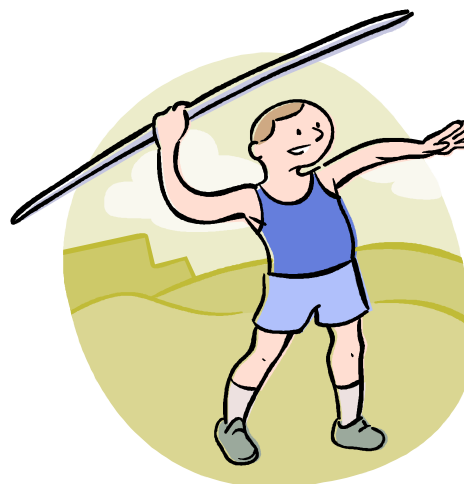
Friday 8th School closes for the half term break.
