

Appendix 1: Sections from the Education and Inspections Act 2006 now in force

Sections 89 – 92 inclusive, Education and Inspections Act 2006

Section 89 EIA 2006:-

- Headteacher to determine measures to promote, self-discipline, good behaviour etc. 'securing that pupils complete any tasks reasonably assigned to them in connection with their education'

Other new measures for determination by Head

- Making of rules and provision for **disciplinary penalties**
- (Section 90 EIA 2006)
- Measures to regulate pupils' conduct when they are not on school premises nor under lawful control or charge of school staff.

Section 90 EIA 2006 meaning of disciplinary penalty

- Means a penalty imposed on the pupil where his 'conduct falls
- below the standard which could reasonably be expected of him
- (whether because he fails to follow a rule in force at any such school or an instruction or for any other reason).

The section also allows the school to penalise the pupil when he is not on the school premises or under control of the school provided "it is reasonable for the school imposing the penalty to regulate the pupil's conduct at such a time". Also, the school can impose a penalty if the pupil does not comply with the penalty previously imposed upon him.
